Friends of Clayoquot Sound, Greenpeace Canada, Sierra Club BC, Wilderness Committee and ForestEthics Solutions congratulate the chiefs and community for their leadership in stewarding their territories in Clayoquot Sound’s globally important rainforests. The majority of Clayoquot’s intact ancient temperate rainforest valleys are in Ahousaht Territory.

We are calling on the BC government to fully support the Ahousaht land use visioning process, reconciliation process and all necessary steps to enable the vision of the Ahousaht for the future of the rainforest in their territory.
