Ahousaht Stewardship Guardian

Position:

The Ahousaht Stewardship Guardian is a position and role created by the Ha'wiih to protect, manage and steward natural resources within our Hahoulthee. Reporting to the Stewardship Director and Stewardship Biologist you will perform data collection and monitoring activities, provide public education on cultural values, build and maintain trails, collect fees under the Stewardship Fund, manage wildlife interactions and report activity within the Hahoulthee. Previous experience in the fields of fisheries and natural resource management is an asset.

Responsibilities:

- Assist with data collection and monitoring activities
- Compile reports
- Act as point of contact for basic communications, including: fisheries openings, harvesting restrictions, communicating resource harvesting activity (logging, road building, construction activity, wildlife harvesting restrictions, fishery closures etc.)
- Coordinate and manage authorized trail building projects.
- Liaise with the Tofino business community.
- Conduct wildlife management surveys and patrols.
- Attend interagency meetings when requested.
- Provide public information and safety briefings.
- Assist with all search and rescue efforts when directed.
- Boat safety and maintenance
- Other duties as required.

Skills/Qualifications:

- SVOP certification required
- Minimum 3 years experience operating a marine vessel in the hahuuthlii
- Grade 12 Equivalency.
- Preferred professional accreditation in wildlife management or resource management or an acceptable combination of education and experience.
- General office experience with scheduling, filing and logistics management.
- Computer literacy and proficiency with Microsoft Office tools (Excel, Word, PowerPoint.)
- Excellent communication, listening and professional writing skills.
- High professional and ethical standards.
- Positive attitude, energetic and eager to work in a fast paced, dynamic environment as part of a team.
- Must be dependable, have a high attention to detail, be able to work independently, and be willing to sign a confidentiality agreement.
